1. Completely fill out the application. Other than the Conditions of Approval section, be sure to complete all sections on the form. The Conditions of Approval section will be completed by the Noise Control Officer (NCO) if the request is approved.
2. Submit the application to: code@cupertino.org
- 3a. **Application is denied.** If after the preliminary review of the application it is determined there is not sufficient justification or hardship to approve the request, you will be notified.
- 3b. **Application process moves forward.** If after the preliminary review the application shows sufficient justification or hardship to justify the request, proceed to step 4.
4. If property is within 750 ft of a Residential property, a notification shall be sent to all residential property owners and tenants to notify them of the pending construction outside normal business hours at least 14 days in advance of the requested construction.
