The City of Cupertino, in partnership with consultants Opticos Design Inc., is working on a community-driven design process to create a specific plan for the Vallco Special Area. These plans will establish development standards and land use patterns for the 58 acres at the northwest corner of Wolfe Road and Stevens Creek



Boulevard and southeast of Wolfe Road and 280. On February 5, 2018, the City and Opticos hosted

a project kick-off meeting at Community Hall for the Vallco Special Area Specific Plan. The kick-off meeting is only the first of many planned opportunities for community members to stay involved with the process, including design charrettes in April and May.

The City's General Plan requires that a specific plan be prepared for the Vallco area, not only for the mall property, but for the entire plan area. A specific plan establishes the rules of development, including the desired vision for an area through a framework of objective standards for land use, site layout, streetscape, open space, buildings, and more. The specific plan will provide a high level of predictability for how the project is developed.
