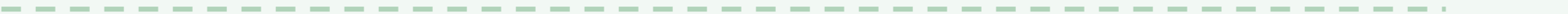

- Encourage students to bike to school

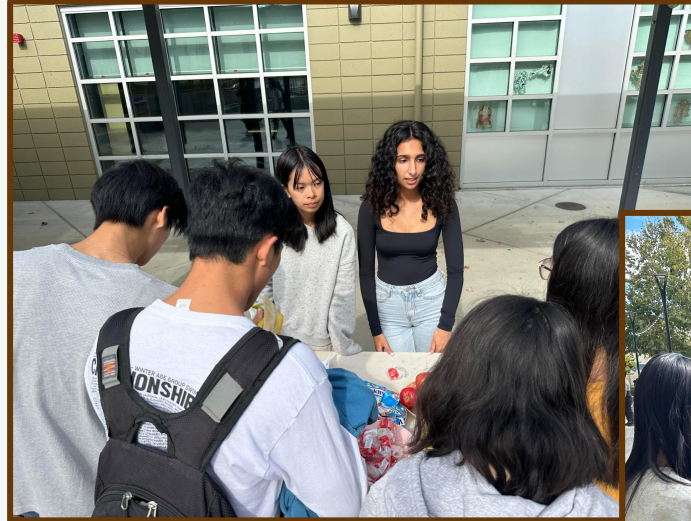

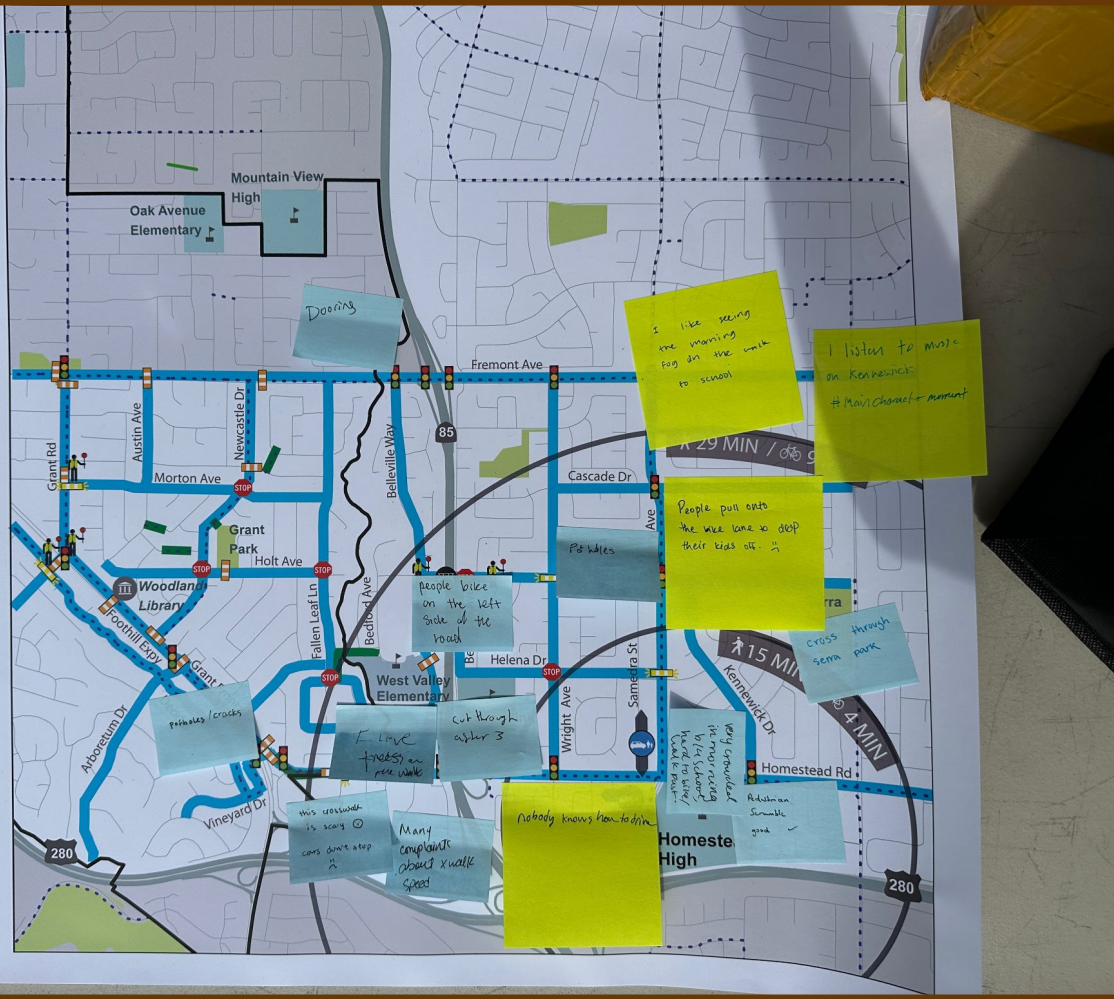


## Improvements/Ideas

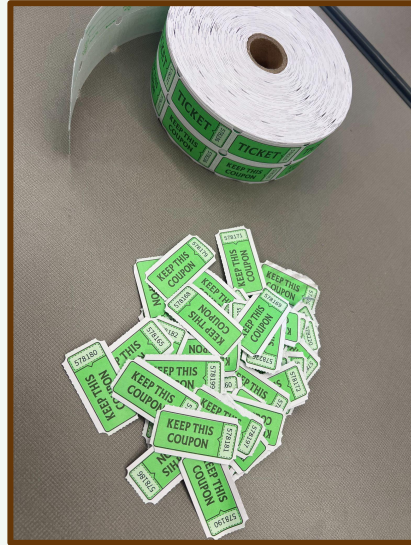

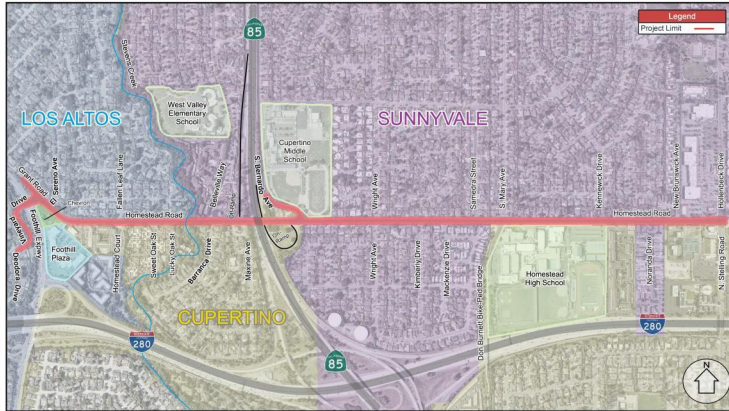
## Improvements/Ideas
