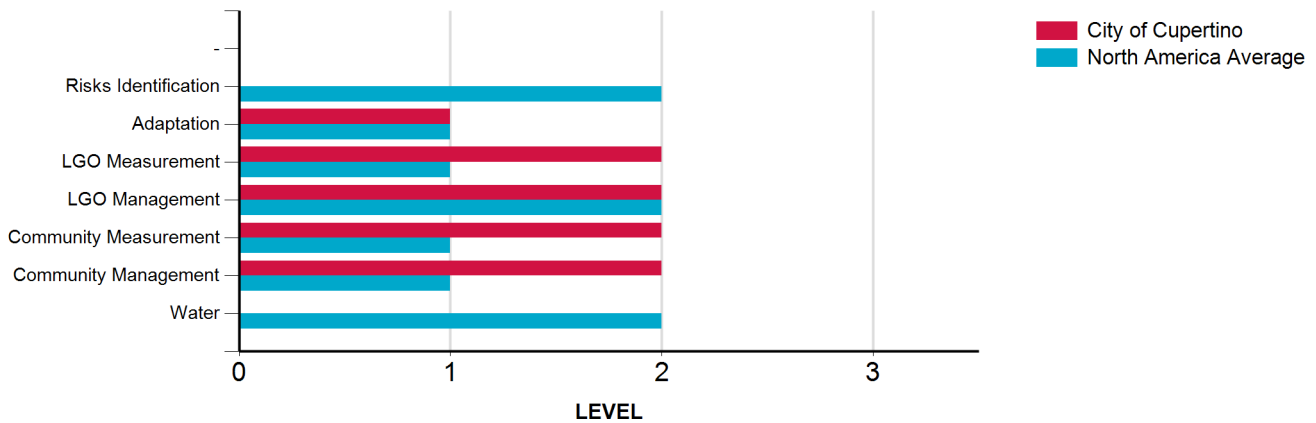

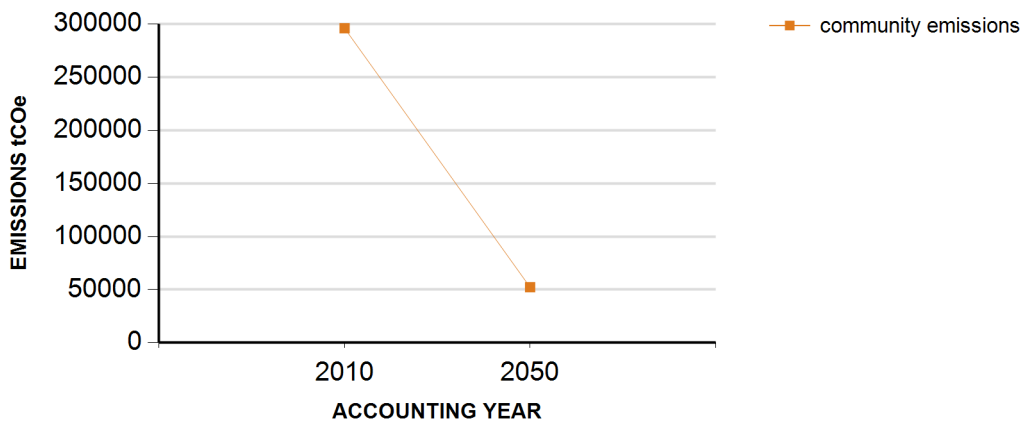

This graph shows your most recently reported emissions against your baseline and absolute emissions target (if reported).

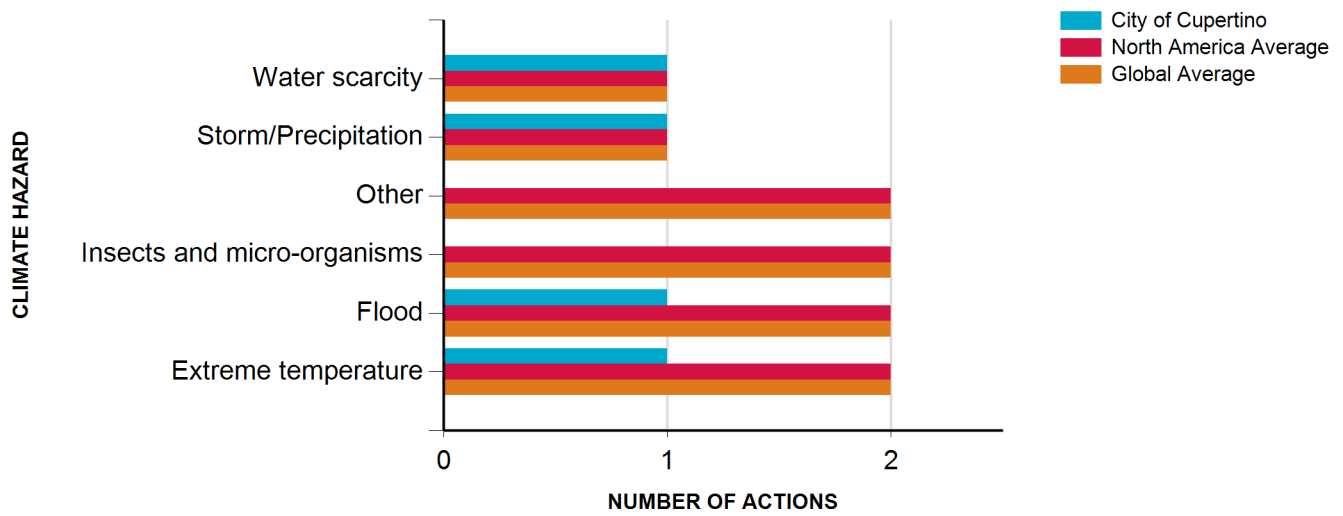

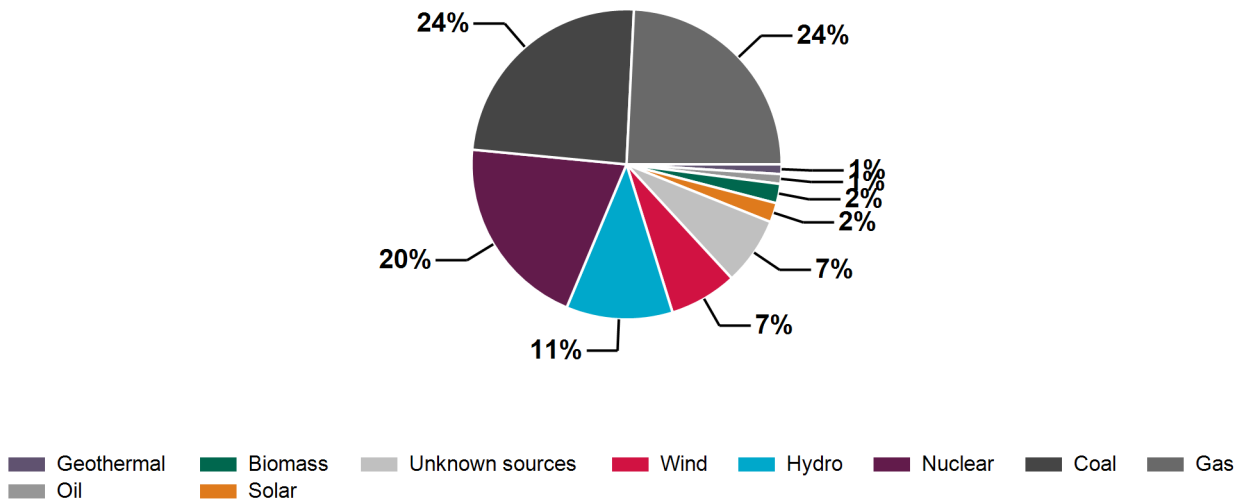
Number of Adaptation Actions by Climate Hazard
