Scheduled COVID-19 testing appointments are available this week from today through Friday, August 28 from 12 p.m. to 6:30 p.m. and Saturday, August 30 from 9 a.m. to 3 p.m. at the Santa Clara County Fairgrounds, 344 Tully Road, in Lot A across from the main entrance for people with or without symptoms. The site is set up for drive-through testing, but there is a bike and pedestrian entrance available off 7th Street at the corner of Tully Road.
