Cupertino Veteran's Day Ceremony Wednesday, November 11 at 11am

CUPERTINO, CA – On Wednesday, November 11 at 11am, Cupertino will honor veterans at a ceremony held at Memorial Park, located at Mary Avenue and Stevens Creek Boulevard, in Cupertino, in front of The Guardians Statue. The Guardians is an image of two defenders, ever watchful, back to back. The two soldiers represented are Cupertino's own Matthew Axelson, and James Suh, two Navy SEAL's who died fighting the Taliban in Afghanistan during [Operation Red Wings](#), recently dramatized in the movie, *Lone Survivor*.

This year, the Cupertino Veterans Day Ceremony will honor all veterans and active-duty military.

The Veterans Day ceremony from Cupertino's Memorial Park will be aired LIVE on KMVT at 11am on November 11th on Comcast channel 15 and ATT Uverse channel 99, in the cities of Cupertino, Mountain View, and Los Altos.
