# ICLEI USA AND OFFICE DEPOT AWARD CUPERTINO \$20,000 FOR GREEN BUSINESS PROGRAM

City of Cupertino, CA – May 19, 2014 — ICLEI Local Governments for Sustainability-USA (ICLEI), in partnership with Office Depot, Inc., awarded \$20,000 in support to the City of Cupertino for the national Green Business Challenge. The City of Cupertino joins Houston, TX, West Palm Beach, FL, and Lexington, KY as one of four cities in the nation to receive the Green Business Challenge implementation pack. Valued at \$20,000, this competitive award includes in-kind contributions, software, and technical assistance.

The City will use the award to enhance its already award-winning green business program, <u>GreenBiz Cupertino</u>. GreenBiz provides technical assistance local businesses, property managers, and other organizations to conserve resources, reduce waste, save utility costs, improve purchasing decisions, and prevent pollution. The Green Business Challenge will expand on these existing services, help businesses track and elevate environmental performance, and recognize them for their environmental achievements.

"GreenBiz Cupertino is a highly successful program in our community. ICLEI's Green Business Challenge will take our program to the next level by having businesses compete against each other to achieve environmental excellence," said Cupertino Mayor Gilbert Wong. "This support from ICLEI and Office Depot will help us strengthen the program and improve our community."

Launched in Chicago in 2008, the Green Business Challenge now serves as a model for communities nationwide seeking to drive environmental action in the private sector through friendly competition. Participating businesses compete for points, and access resources and best practices identified by the community and ICLEI, using an online software platform. Since its launch, over 124 million kilowatt-hours of electricity and more than 85,000 metric tons of carbon emissions have been saved among the Challenge's Round 2 participants.

"Since we helped launch the first Green Business Challenge with ICLEI and the City of Chicago in 2008, the program has grown into a powerful national movement," said Yalmaz Siddiqui, Senior Director of Environmental and Supplier Diversity Strategy for Office Depot. "The success and expansion of Green Business Challenge shows that by working together the public and private sector can create a very meaningful positive change towards environmental sustainability."

The Green Business Challenge will launch here in Cupertino in the coming months with ICLEI's support.
