Upcoming freeway on-ramp and lane closures due to construction at I-280 and CA-85 in Cupertino

Beginning on Friday, July 25, towers will be put in place as part of construction of a bicycle pedestrian bridge across 280 at Mary Avenue.

On Friday, July 25, the north tower (Homestead High School) will be assembled and placed on its final foundation beginning at 11:00 PM, Friday. The northbound off-ramp to CA-85, from northbound 280 will be closed to traffic. This closure will remain in place until 5:00 AM, Saturday morning. The same closure will be instituted again on the next night, Saturday July 26 at 11:00 PM and reopened Sunday morning at 5:00 AM.

On Friday August 1, the south tower (Mary Ave by the Oaks Shopping Center) will be assembled and placed on its foundation. The on-ramps from north and southbound 85 onto southbound 280 will be closed Friday, August 1, from Midnight to 6:00 AM. The same closure will occur on Saturday, August 2, midnight to 6:00 AM to finish the work.

No lane restrictions to north or southbound 280 are anticipated.

In addition to construction staff, the California Highway Patrol, Caltrans and the Santa Clara County Sheriff's office have coordinated these closures.
