New Garbage Containers to Arrive at Cupertino Curbsides

Residents will start to see new, wheeled garbage containers at the curbs by the end of the month. The new, grey carts replace trash cans residents currently set out for collection. The garbage carts, delivered at no extra cost, are part of the City's new semi-automated garbage and recycling program.

Residents should begin using the new carts once they receive them. Carts must be placed in the street with wheels against the curb by 6 a.m. on regular trash pick-up days. Carts should be at least 18-inches away from parked cars and recycling containers.

All garbage carts will be delivered by March 25. The delivery of blue, wheeled carts for recycling immediately follows throughout the month of April.

Old garbage cans that no longer are useful can be removed on one of two free, annual On-Call Disposal days.
