City's Free Shredding Day Recycles, Protects Personal Information

Cupertino residents can recycle confidential paperwork easily, securely and for free during the City's first Shredding Day event on Saturday, April 16.

Beginning at 8 a.m. until noon, residents may bring up to two bankers boxes-full of paperwork to the Cupertino City Hall parking lot, 10300 Torre Ave., where employees of Shred-it, a leading on-site document destruction company, will unload the boxes from vehicles and take them directly to in-truck shredders. Residents may watch as their documents are destroyed. Participants are asked to bring a valid driver's license or California identification card to verify residency.

The Shredding Day event is offered as part of Cupertino's ongoing effort to promote recycling and to prevent identity theft.
