Veteran's Day Ceremony

CUPERTINO, CA – This year's Veterans Day Ceremony from Cupertino's Memorial Park will be aired LIVE on KMVT at 11am on November 11th on Comcast channel 15 and ATT Uverse channel 99, in the cities of Cupertino, Mountain View, and Los Altos.

The event will replay on the channel throughout November, Sundays at 1pm, and can be viewed online at KMVT's YouTube channel: youTube.com/user/KMVT

The ceremony will be held at Memorial Park, located at Mary Avenue and Stevens Creek Boulevard, Cupertino, in front of The Guardians Statue. The Guardians is an image of two defenders, ever watchful, back to back. The two soldiers represented are Cupertino's own Matthew Axelson, and James Suh, two Navy SEAL's who died fighting the Taliban in Afghanistan during Operation Red Wings, recently dramatized in the movie, *Lone Survivor*.

Each year on November 11, people across America gather to recognize and honor the contributions and sacrifices of our veterans. This year, the Cupertino Veterans Day Ceremony will honor all veterans and active-duty military.
