Project Background

- 2016-2017: Citywide School Walk Audit identified need to improve bicycle safety at Lawson
 - Lawson student biking grown from 3% in 2016 to 11% in 2021
 - 2018-2022: Conditions and options explored by City / School / District / PTA / Parents
 - 2022: City contracted with Hexagon to take a fresh look at conditions and options by conducting this feasibility study

 - Bike and pedestrian usage, travelling patterns
 - Parking demand on Vista, Merritt
 - Peak school usage times
 - Peak residential usage times
 - Parking demand during summer track/field
 - Community/Stakeholder Meetings + Alternatives Development (pros/cons and cost of each alternative)
 - Bicycle Pedestrian Commission, City Council
